

FUTURE: BE GOING TO



How do we use the **BE GOING TO** form for the future?

To talk about certain future plans and intentions.

Future plans

Sara **is going to buy** a new house.



To predict something (with evidence)

Predict something

There are dark clouds. It's **going to rain!**



Inglés

AFFIRMATIVE FORM



+ verb "to be" + going to + infinitive + complement.

Example:

I **am going to travel** to an incredible place.



NEGATIVE FORM



+ verb "to be" + not going to + infinitive + complement.

Examples:



They **are** not going to **eat** meat,
they are vegetarians.



He **isn't** going to **study** tonight.

QUESTION FORM



Verb "to be" +  + going to + infinitive + complement + ?

Examples:

Is she going to tell us what to study for the test?

Short
answers

Yes, she is.
No, she isn't.

Are they going to take a rest in the afternoon?

Short
answers

Yes, they are.
No, they aren't.



QUESTION FORM



Wh-word + **Verb "to be"** +  + **going to** + **infinitive** + **complement** + **?**

Examples:

Where are you going to spend your holidays?



I am going to spend my holidays in Brazil.



What is Juan going to have for lunch?

He is going to have a fried chicken.

WOULD LIKE and WOULD LIKE TO

We use **would like** or **would like to** when making offers and requests to politely say what we want, now, or at some time in the future.

I would like candy after dinner.
or
I'd like candy after dinner.



Contraction:

I would like = I'd like


AFFIRMATIVE FORM

Example:

It'd like chicken for lunch today.



	would like to	verb	complement
---	----------------------	-------------	-------------------


Example:

Mary would like to go to the park.


NEGATIVE FORM



	<p>would NOT like</p>	<p>noun</p>	<p>complement</p>
--	------------------------------	--------------------	--------------------------

Example:

He **would not like** an **expensive car.**



	<p>would NOT like <u>to</u></p>	<p>verb</p>	<p>complement</p>
--	--	--------------------	--------------------------

Example:

She **would not like to leave** late at night.
